 - **a.** <u>Completed</u>: North Bound Preload; Settlement Platforms South Bound; Clearing and half of aggregate base completed North of turnpike. Will commence work on South side once slope failure restoration complete.
 - **b.** <u>Southern Slope Failure:</u> As soon as MDOT completes review of findings, borings will commence; light fill will be added (considering geo-foam blocks) This will not affect construction schedule.
 - c.
