2015 ETA Annual Meeting Speakers' Bios

Paul Schumacher has been the Executive Director at *Southern Maine Planning and Development Commission* (SMPDC) since 1996. Prior to that he worked as a town planner in several southern Maine towns and also at a consulting firm on Cape Cod. Paul has a B.A. from the University of New Hampshire and a master's degree in urban/environmental policy from Tufts University. His professional interests revolve around creating healthy communities and including all relevant interest groups from social service organizations to economic developers to environmentalists in the discussion of what that community should be. His family's favorite place to vacation is Maine — all of it.

Tin Smith is the Stewardship Coordinator at the *Wells National Estuarine Research Reserve* and the Board President of the *Great Works Regional Land Trust*. In both roles he works with landowners and communities providing information and services for improving stewardship of natural resources including the establishment and maintenance of trails. The Great Works Regional Land Trust has completed 117 projects protecting over 5,300 acres in the three Berwicks, Eliot, Wells and Ogunquit and over 30,000 people visit the Reserve annually with many of them taking advantage of the seven-mile trail system on the coast.

Lee Burnett, chair of the *Sanford Trails Committee*, has been a trails champion since college days when he worked on a summer trail crew in the White Mountains. In Sanford, he has been instrumental in landing grant money, sponsoring AmeriCorps teams, developing an outdoor recreation map, forming a bike/ped committee and developing a farm trail walk.
