- 3. President Hamblen reported that the top coat on Dennett Road will not be applied this season because the supplier did not deliver the material. A spring completion is expected. Anita Rosencrantz reported biking the section and that it is much better than before the project was started.
- 4. President Hamblen reported the Kennebunk-Biddeford project design review meeting with Unitil went well with no show-stoppers. HNTB will begin final design unless there are surprises at the 17 December public meeting.
- 5. John Andrews reported that Thunderhead Alliance and East Coast Greenway Alliance are lobbying Congress for economic stimulus package funds to build three "ready to build" sections of the ET.
 - a. The South Portland-Scarborough gap. \$3.3 million

- b. The Old Orchard Beach-Saco gap. \$1.3 million
- c. An extension of the newly opened Scarborough-OOB section to add a mile to reach Cascade Road. \$0.5 million.
- 6. The Board brainstormed how to select a next section and how to obtain corporate funding for new sections. There were no motions.
- 7. Jessica Wagner moved we adjourn at 9:50. Seconded by Bruce Gullifer. Approved by acclamation.
